## Program Description

Field Study & America Plus is a mix of our historic America Plus program and the Field Study program. This program is focused on building English language confidence and American cultural knowledge through our American Communication class, with an additional content course option. Content courses focus on real life experience as the best way to learn, so each in-class day is followed by a field trip or other activity where you will use the language and skills from class with other students and PSU staff. Program Assistants (PSU students) will help you learn about Portland / American culture and be your guide and friendly support for class activities or fun trips like visiting Seattle or Powell's Bookstore (the largest bookstore in the world).
