[Precautions before vaccination]

- •Please make sure to get enough sleep the day before, eat regular meals (especially the breakfast on the day), and keep yourself in good physical condition.
- ·If you have a fever (37.5°C or higher) or other health problems, please refrain from vaccination. (If you wish to refrain from vaccination, please be sure to contact the call center to cancel the vaccination.)
- On the day of vaccination, please arrive at the venue on your appointment time. If you are late for your appointment, you may not be able to receive your vaccination on the day. Please be sure to contact the call center without deciding on your own. Please refrain from arriving more than 10 minutes earlier than your appointment time to prevent the waiting area from becoming crowded.






[What to wear on the day]

Present your Prevaccination Screening Questionnaire, vaccination voucher, certificate of vaccination, and ID for verification of your identity.

Have a doctor's consultation based on your Pre-vaccination Screening Questionnaire.



Receive a vaccine from a nurse.



After the vaccination, the patient will be observed in the monitoring area for 15 to 30 minutes as a follow-up.

[Precautions after vaccination]

•On the day of vaccination, please refrain from strenuous exercise and avoid rubbing the injected area; bathing on the day of vaccination is not a problem.
